



Science Adventure! Instructors

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The A.K.A. Science program is a hands-on, inquiry-based, out-of-school science program for children in grades k-6. The program, which is provided by the nonprofit Oregon Health Career Center, was developed to engage children in science and learning for a lifetime. It uses structured yet playful hands-on activities to encourage observation of the world through exploration. This summer, A.K.A. Science is collaborating with the Wilsonville Library to offer Science Adventure! classes at the Wilsonville Library and Boones Ferry Elementary. Each location will offer fun and interactive science experiences to three grade levels (K-1, 2-3, 4-6).

The Wilsonville Library summer program will start on June 28th and run for 8 weeks.

- Three Science Adventure! classes at the Wilsonville Library on Mondays from 10:30am-11:30am.
- Three Science Adventure! classes at the Wilsonville Library on Mondays from 6:30pm-7:30pm

The Boones Ferry summer program will run Monday through Thursday from August 2nd to August 12th.

- Eight Science Adventure! classes immediately following the lunch program at Boones Ferry Elementary from 12:30pm-1:30pm

VOLUNTEER DESCRIPTION

The Science Adventure! Instructor is a volunteer responsible for delivering A.K.A. Science curriculum during an eight unit session to youth in a summer program. Principle duties include:

- Attend an A.K.A. Science training session prior to leading an A.K.A. Science class;
- Teach A.K.A. Science classes in the manner prescribed by OHCC; and,
- Minimum commitment of 2 hours per unit. (1 hour prep/clean-up time and 1 hour class time)

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS

Ability to:

- Have flexibility with instructing multiple age groups and schedules
- Work effectively and independently in a non-traditional educational environment
- Pay attention to student needs
- Be excited to explore, ask questions and find answers with students
